

# SAMPLE TIMETABLE

Our basic timetable ('clubs' are extra to this):

**8.30 EARLY BIRD Activities** – Art, Games/puzzles, Percussion instruments, Books, Den-building, Going to the Park

**9.15-10.00 Settling in sessions** for parents/carers to stay and play

**10-10.30 WARM UP/WELCOME**

**10.30-11.10 Music or Drama or Sport**

Wash hands for snack

**11.10-11.30 SNACK TIME**

**11.30-12.10 Music or Drama or Sport**

**12.15-12.50 Music or Drama or Sport**

Wash hands for lunch/Morning-onlys pickup time

**13.00-13.45 LUNCH**

**13.45-14.45 Art/Craft – Sport/Games – Den-building – Story telling**

**14.50-15.50 Art/Craft – Sport/Games – Den-building – Story telling**

Gather up belongings for Home time/Wash hands for snack

**16.00-16.15 SNACK/Extended day** – Reviewing the day, Art/Sewing, Games, Books, Den-building

**18.00 HOME TIME**

**Children are grouped into ages (although this is flexible) 3-4, 5-6, 6-7, 8-12** and have a play-based programme appropriate to their age group, delivered with as much fun as possible. The timetable is flexible to suit the needs of the age groups we have that day.

If a child wants to just do sport, they are welcome to choose this, and be a helper for the other age group's sessions. Siblings and friends are able to choose to be in the same sessions until ready to join own age group.

The **Session leaders and staff** are a dedicated and consistent community at Holiday Academy. Some are Cavendish School teachers, and others recommended from local schools, colleges and sports clubs. All are experienced, capable and energetic.

You may book as many or as few days as convenient for you, you do not have to book a whole week. Parents are able to have a personal, flexible and approachable service for booking and queries from Organizer. **The Organizer or Manager** is available on phone/email, and personally at drop-off and pick-up times. We have no nappy changing facilities so all children need to be toilet trained.
